The unrelenting Central Otago environment tortures the vines whose twisted limbs produce a wine worthy of absolution; strong and sensual with lashings of dark fruit, sinfully succulent and devilishly good.

The flavours are practically immoral, full of black Doris plums, flame-toasted oak and bramble fruit crème brûlée, and will leave you with an insatiable desire for more.
