## **Rockburn 08 Pinot Noir Wins Gold Medal**

Rockburn 08 Pinot Noir has won a Gold medal at the Bragato Wine Awards announced at the 2009 Bragato Conference held at Napier this weekend.

Rockburn 08 Pinot Gris won a Silver medal at the same event.

The Bragato Wine Awards are organised by NZ Winegrowers and give recognition to viticultural excellence and recognise that "good wines are grown in the vineyard". They are held in honour of Romeo Bragato, a viticultural pioneer, whose work between 1895 and 1912 set the foundations for the New Zealand wine industry as it stands today.

Rockburn Wines has a history of winning gold medals, particularly for its Pinot Noir, at such shows as the Air New Zealand Awards, the New Zealand International Wine Show and the New Zealand Royal Easter Show.

Rockburn Wines has two vineyards in Central Otago, one in Gibbston Valley and the other at Lowburn. While renowned for its Pinot Noir, Rockburn also produces Pinot Gris, Riesling, Gewurztraminer, Chardonnay and Sauvignon Blanc.
