## **Rockburn Whites Win Silver Medals at the NZ International Wine Show**

Rockburn white wines won three silver medals at the New Zealand International Wine Show in Auckland.

Silver medals were awarded to:

- Rockburn 2007 Parkburn Riesling
- Rockburn 2008 Sauvignon Blanc
- Rockburn 2007 Chardonnay

The New Zealand International Wine Show is the largest wine show in New Zealand. The judging of the 2009 show took place over three days between 7<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> September. Bob Campbell MW headed the team of experienced judges and between them they tasted over 2,000 wines.

156 Gold medals, 317 Silver medals and 791 Bronze medals were awarded.

Rockburn winemaker, Malcolm Rees-Francis, said that he was delighted the awards for the Rockburn whites. "We have had a history of producing award winning Pinot Noirs so it is tremendous to see our white wines starting to get similar recognition."

Rockburn Wines has two vineyards in Central Otago, one in Gibbston Valley and the other at Lowburn. While renowned for its Pinot Noir, Rockburn also produces Pinot Gris, Riesling, Gewurztraminer, Chardonnay and Sauvignon Blanc.
