

Rockburn Wines Open New Cellar Door

Rockburn Wines are delighted to announce the opening of their new tasting facility at their winery at McNulty Road, Cromwell.



The winery itself opened in April for the bumper 2006 vintage. However, the tasting area has taken longer to complete. The tasting area was designed by Dalmain Architects and features rock paneling and a large wooden tasting bench. The rock panels continue the theme on the outside of the winery.

“The new tasting facility allows us to promote Rockburn Wines, both to existing customers and the expanding wine tourism industry in Central Otago” says Catherine Badrak, Rockburn’s Cellar Door Manager.

Rockburn, renowned for its award winning Pinot Noirs, also produce Pinot Gris, Chardonnay, Gewurztraminer, Riesling and Sauvignon Blanc. The 2006 whites will be released in October.

Rockburn Wines has two vineyards in Central Otago, one in Gibbston and the other at Lowburn. Wines are now made at their own winery by winemaker, Malcolm Francis.

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
