TASTING NOTES

The fruity and saucy side of Central Otago Pinot Noir is bound up in this bottle of Stolen Kiss Pinot Noir; once unleashed into your glass its bright berry and cherry aromas shall sashay into a lip-smacking Black Forest gateaux and poached plum palate, fortified by toasty oak. Most fun to drink with friends!

Grape Variety & Clone:	Pinot Noir 2/15, 2/21
Training and Trellis:	Vertical Shoot Position (VSP)
Soils:	Pisa 10-15 cm loam over river gravel Gibbston 40cm loam over alluvial gravels
Vineyard Location:	Pisa and Gibbston sub-regions
Climate Comment:	Beautiful sunny season, some rain/snow events in January
Vintage Climate:	Settled, a few rain or frost events, short
Harvest Date:	Throughout April and early May
Viticulturist Comment:	A cool flowering period reduced overall yields.

Fermentation:	7t fermenters with varying time on skins. Some parcels given oak elevage, others not.
Alcohol:	13.5 %
Titrateable Acidity:	6.5g/L

Vintage Comment:	Cool climate expression.
